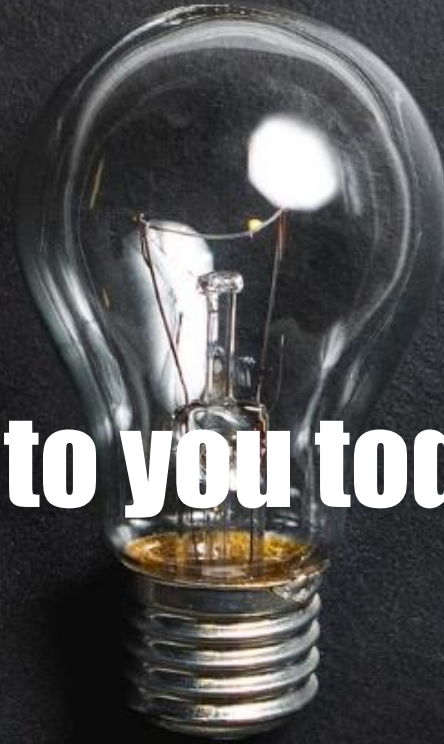



The global refugee crisis?

- **There are 70.8 million forcibly displaced people around the world**
- **These people have fled extreme dangers, to escape relentless bombing, invading armies, gang violence, or other life-threatening circumstances.**
- **Those who have been uprooted from their homes often facing further struggles on their journey to find safety, including access to clean water, food, shelter, personal security, and health care.**
- **Every year, millions of people are driven from their homes by war, political unrest, economic upheaval,**
